A 1,368-bed Comprehensive Stroke Center in Orlando, Florida is equipped with the latest technology and expertise to perform advanced diagnostic, medical, and surgical procedures.

The Problem

The door-to-needle (DTN) administration time began to increase during Q4 2019. Our Quality Program Specialist and the hospital's Stroke Coordinator conducted a comprehensive data review to identify opportunities for improvement. It was identified that the root cause of the increased DTN time was due to delayed activation of TeleNeurologists.

The Result

The improvement strategy deployed was re-education on prompt activation upon stroke identification with staff. Additionally, we provided continuous monitoring and data feedback.

A 15% reduction in DTN was achieved between December 2019 and June 2020.

The Takeaways

- The hospital noticed DTN times increasing
- They completed a comprehensive data review with us to determine areas of improvement
- After re-education, DTN medians have improved by 15%
